The Gettysburg Area local churches provide shelter sites from October through April for residents and families experiencing the loss of housing. At the Gettysburg Cares Resource Center guests can shower, do their laundry, apply for jobs and services, re-establish independence and improve the quality of their lives. Great Conewago Presbyterian houses the homeless in our Christian Education Building for several weeks every year. With the assistance of the Gettysburg Presbyterian Church's van our guests are transported to us each evening and transported from our facility each morning to the Gettysburg Cares Resource Center for daytime program assistance.

Our facilities are widely used by local groups for special functions, weddings and baby showers. Our local Hunterstown Ruritan Club, as a community service, assists us in the cleaning of the Christian Education Building and our parishioners care for the Church Sanctuary Building since there is no paid custodian.



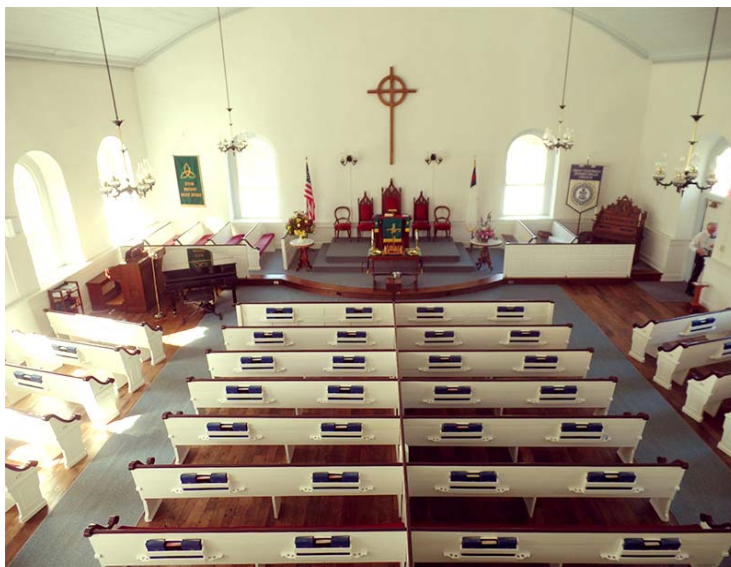
Gettysburg Cares
