In 2017, for the fourth time, Monaghan Presbyterian Church was involved in the Youth Impact Project in Dillsburg. In late July this project provides many needed items to children and youth for the approaching school year. Students can get sneakers, backpacks, books, groceries, hair cuts, and even photographs. Typically Youth Impact is held on a Friday evening, for special needs students, and all day on a Saturday.

Each year Monaghan sponsors the prayer tent at the Youth Impact event. Pastor Janice Tiedeck is instrumental in this effort, where prayers are said for the coming school year, and Bibles are given to students, who desire them. Also, Monaghan provides 250 items for the grocery tent. In 2017, they provided facial tissues. In other years toothpaste and canned fruit were given. Additionally, members donate backpacks, sneakers, and school supplies. Pastor Tiedeck and many other members of Monaghan help staff the different rooms on the day of the event.



This year Youth Impact in Dillsburg served over 1500 children from 637 families.
