(High School and College-Aged Youth in June 2018)



Our Presbytery has been working in close partnership with the Presbyterian Church in Honduras for more than a decade. A beautiful fruit of our partnership is the growth of our shared, new-home, construction ministry. Our Presbytery has made an intentional commitment to urban mission work in the city of Tegucigalpa serving in cooperation with three robust congregations in different neighborhoods (Pena de Horeb, Tierra Prometida, and Roca de Israel Presbyterian Churches). These congregations are responsible for all aspects of the home construction ministry. Our Youth Mission Team will actively work along side of the Honduran mission committee and construction workers building a new home.

Youth interested in this mission trip should:

- be eager to participate in heavy construction work;
- be motivated to spiritually grow while immersed in a cross-cultural experience, which includes deep, urban poverty;
- be motivated to seek relationships and build friendships in a non-English speaking context;
- seek the blessing of relationships with Honduran Presbyterians;
- bring a servant's heart both in relationship to our other team members, and our Honduran brothers and sisters.;
- and have an up-to-date passport.
