VII. Presbytery-wide Ministry Initiatives

- 1. At its meetings, presbytery may choose to address topics of common concern to its congregations by designating such topics as presbytery-wide ministry initiatives.
- 2. When presbytery selects an initiative, the Coordinating Council shall appoint teams of five to seven persons to study, gather resources and propose or implement strategies relevant to the initiative. The Nominating Committee shall work as directed by the Coordinating Council to recruit persons to serve.
- 3. Such a presbytery-wide ministry initiative will normally be pursued for three years to allow for preparation, implementation and evaluation, but presbytery may extend this time for up to an additional three years, as it deems necessary.
- 4. No more than three presbytery-wide ministry initiatives shall be pursued concurrently.
