Guiding Principles and Mission Statement

Guiding Principles:

- (1) Our Presbytery needs to <u>shift from an emphasis on being a regulatory agency to an emphasis on being a service community</u> by supporting congregations in addressing their needs and opportunities and by increasing resources, information and training for mission and ministry.
- (2) Our Presbytery needs to <u>shift</u> from a communication pattern where the Presbytery supplies information and persuades participation <u>to dialogue in which congregations and Presbytery actively talk to and listen to each other and respond to one another.</u>
- (3) Our Presbytery needs to <u>shift the attitude about the relationship among congregations and the Presbytery</u> from one that is at times suspicious, and fearful <u>to one that is more collegial and collaborative in ministry</u>.

Mission Statement:

To pursue these three Guiding Principles, the Planning Team recommends the adoption of a new mission statement for our new vision and calling:

The Presbytery of Carlisle Exists to Support Our Congregations for Faithful Service to God in the Name of Jesus Christ.
