

## Call of the Stated Meeting of The Presbytery of Carlisle

The Presbytery of Carlisle will meet **Tuesday, September 24, 2019** at the **Central Presbyterian Church in Chambersburg, PA**. Registration opens at 3:30. The meeting begins at **4:00 PM** with the **Examination of Candidate Joaquin Anabe Lopez for ordination to the Ministry of Word and Sacrament**. Joaquin has been called to a Clinical Pastoral Residency with the Hershey Medical Center. As is our custom, Joaquin's examination will include the proclamation of God's Word, in a sermon preached before the presbytery, the reading of his [Statement of Faith](#) and opportunity for presbyters to examine Joaquin on the basis of his calling, gifts, preparation, and suitability for the Ministry of Word and Sacrament.

**Dinner** will be served at 5:00 p.m., at a cost of \$8.00 per person. During the dinner hour we will lift up [Ministers' Milestones](#). And, we'll **celebrate the ministry of Suzanne Lemon Souder**, who has retired after 33 years of service to the Presbytery of Carlisle. ### What else is Happening at the Presbytery Meeting?

This Presbytery meeting is designed to be an offering of our gifts in service to Christ's mission. Each part of the meeting will be a reflection of our stewardship of the gifts God has given, in and through our congregations:

In **Worship**...we'll offer our hearts, minds and voices to God, and center our gathering in God's Word and Spirit. Through Scripture, song, movement and prayer we'll consider God's call to transformative partnerships.

In a **Learning Experience**...we'll get to watch Kim Wadlington, pastor at Middle Spring, interview Dori Hjalmarson, Mission Co-Worker in Honduras. Then, around tables, presbyters will meet "Table Hosts" from all over the presbytery who are engaged in transformative mission partnerships, both locally and in other parts of the world. We'll consider together how God may be cultivating future strength for the gospel through our relationships beyond the walls of our churches. Finally, we'll learn about a "Covenant" describing new intentions for the partnership between our congregations and the Presbyterian congregations of Honduras.

In the **Reports and Actions** brought before us, we'll consider how our gifts of people and money, purpose and place are reflected in plans and intentions for the year ahead. As we continue to navigate our ever-changing context, we'll consider proposals intended to make space for discernment of a vision that connects our congregations in discipleship, mission, and faithful witness!

While presbytery meetings bring together teaching and ruling elders for a few significant hours of interaction, there are lots of Presbyterians, all over our presbytery, who are not directly touched by what happens at a presbytery meeting. And we don't want them to be left out! And so....
