

## Krislund Camp and Retreat Center

The Joint Camp and Retreat Center Board of Krislund has approved a suggested change to the camp's bylaws. This change will need to be approved by the three presbyteries who share ownership and operation of Camp Krislund.

Article 5 of the Krislund By-laws is recommended to read (changes in red):

- The voting members of the Joint Camp and Conference Committee shall consist of 3 persons each, of Carlisle, Huntingdon, and Northumberland Presbyteries and up to 3 at-large members who could be members or nonmembers of these three presbyteries. At large members are nominated by board members and elected by the board. Each Presbytery shall elect one person who will be Chairperson of its own Camp & Conference Committee. Members shall be elected in three classes of 1 person each. Elected members shall be elected for two-year terms. They shall be eligible for re-election for two additional consecutive term. The Joint Committee shall be organized in accordance with the Krislund Camp and Committee Center Policy Manual.

Details regarding how this will be worked out will be spelled out in the camp's Manual of Operations.

This proposed change is shared with Carlisle Presbytery for first reading. Comments and questions may be directed to our presbytery's representatives to the Joint Camp and Retreat Center Board, or to the Interim Executive Presbyter.
